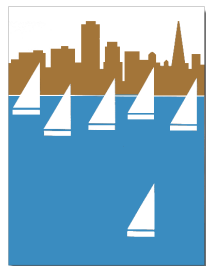

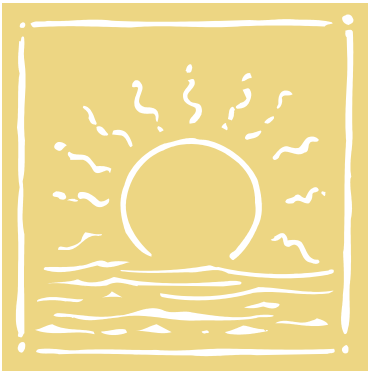


### Annual Parking Passes

**Parking Pass...** In October 2011 we will mail 2012 parking pass applications. Although the parking applications will be mailed they can also be downloaded at: [www.southbeachharbor.com](http://www.southbeachharbor.com). Completed forms can be faxed, mailed or emailed. If mailed a return addressed envelope will be provided. Please do not use the payment envelopes to return your parking form, it will go to the bank.

Starting in 2008 we began adhering to the deadline of December 15 for submitting your application. This year will be no exception. If an application received after that date there will be a \$50 charge for the pass. Insurance and Registration must be current and on file before your Parking Pass will be released to you.

## Towing Boats

**What You Should Know Before You Tow.....** As a member of the recreational boating community, it's a natural impulse to assist fellow boaters in distress. But if your assistance involves towing another vessel, here are some important factors you should keep in mind.

- As a Good Samaritan you MAY BE protected by the Good Samaritan law, but you cannot go beyond your ability, knowledge or training.
- ANY compensation you accept what-so-ever will negate any protection under that law (even a couple of bucks to reimburse you for fuel).
- Be aware that as soon as you tie onto that other boat, YOU have taken total responsibility for that vessel and its crew. You are the Captain of both vessels.
- All persons aboard a towed vessel must wear a Life Jacket by Federal and State laws.

Don't let this stop you from helping out a fellow boater in trouble. Just use good judgment. If conditions aren't just right think it through and when in doubt help the party in distress reach Vessel Assist (877-422-9869)
